As part of your summer reading, you will need to complete the chapter comprehension questions for every chapter and one of the following creative projects: 1. **Board game**- Create a board game based on Fudge's adventures (using a poster board). 2. **Friendly letter**- Write a letter to Peter, reassuring him that he is not a "fourth grade nothing." Share personal experiences of feeling like a "nothing" and how to overcome it. 3. **Sequel writing**- Write a sequel to the story, continuing the adventures of Peter and Fudge. 4. **Commercial planning**- Plan your own commercial, just like Fudge does in the book.
