The caring atmosphere of The Calverton School is extended to the hours after school from 3:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. Our experienced staff offers you peace of mind knowing that your child is safe, comfortable, and engaged in worthwhile activities during our quality Extended Day Program.

The tuition includes a nutritious snack, activities, including arts and crafts, inside and outside free play, and supervised homework. Space is limited, and priority is given to children who enroll on a full-time basis. This can be included in all payment plans. A student information form and medical form must be on file with the Extended Day staff by August 23, 2024. You may choose from one of the following plans:

**Discipline Policy for Extended Day:** When a child is having a challenging time getting along with others, or when inappropriate behavior is causing a problem, a "time-out" may be necessary. The "time-out" is determined by the age of the child and will be based on one minute for each year. When the "time-out" is over, the child will be redirected to another activity of his/her choice. If a child continues to be disruptive, or makes unwise choices, another "time-out" may be required, and a staff member will discuss the problem with the parent.
