

MS/US Dean of Students

Reporting to the MS/US Division Head, The Calverton School in Huntingtown, Maryland is seeking a full-time Dean of Students for the 2025 - 2026 school year. The school seeks a passionate, experienced educator to serve as dean of students. The dean of students is the primary advocate for students in the division and is responsible for all non-academic, student-related matters. This position will work collaboratively and in full partnership with the division head and advisors to design, refine, and nurture a student experience that meets the unique needs and opportunities of our students. The Dean of Students is an 11-month position.

Responsibilities & Essential Functions:

- Demonstrate visible, active leadership in the daily life of the school, including during the daily routines of arrival, dismissal, lunch, and break times as well as at major divisional and school functions and events such as those that occur beyond the school day.
- Create and oversee student programming, including grade-level retreats, clubs, activities, and student leadership opportunities. Encourage student enthusiasm for, and sense of community in the school by generating student support for school activities and developing class programs.
- Oversee the student experience and foster a school climate that enhances community and student growth, fostering a caring, positive and engaging learning environment.
- Oversee a systematic approach to discipline framed within the Philosophy of Honor, coordinating with the Middle School/Upper School Division Head and Head of School on violations of major school rules.
- Oversee day-to-day disciplinary issues, working closely with faculty and staff to ensure compliance with school policies. Responsible for communicating with students, parents, and pertinent faculty about student discipline incidents and consequences.
- Lead Honor Council for Upper School students, when needed, including training students and faculty as participants.
- Collaborate regularly with the school counselor, administrative team, and faculty to support student social/emotional needs and community building.
- Create advisory curriculum, applicable to grades 6 through 12. Ensures implementation of curriculum for all students in Middle and Upper School.



- Create leadership curriculum, applicable to grades 6 through 12. Collaborates with Lower School Head to ensure continuity of student experience with building character and leadership skills. Nurture and coach student leaders.
- Collaborate with the division head on the production and distribution of the student handbook.
- Teach one course—either a full-year class or an elective offering.
