

For 2024/25 Supervised Study Hall for Middle/Upper School 3:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Supervised Study Hall for Middle and Upper School students is a program intended to offer students an opportunity to study, either independently or as a group, after school has ended for the day.

Students are in the MS/US Library and will have access to research materials, plus a supervised environment in which to work. A faculty member will supervise the students during this time.

The program will be on a drop-in basis, requiring students to sign in and out. The fee is \$5.00 per day and will be billed monthly on the student's FACTS invoice. Any Middle or Upper School student remaining on campus after 3:30 p.m., who is not in a supervised activity, is expected to attend Supervised Study Hall, and will be billed accordingly. Any student not picked up by 6:00 p.m. will be assessed late fees of \$25.00 per 15-minute increment.
